


To Whom It May Concern

Luana has been contracted by the Stewart Centre @ EIT for the past 16 weeks to provide Tai Chi to clients and staff.

The Stewart Centre @ EIT is a day rehabilitation service for people with brain injuries, where we received referrals and funding from ACC and the Ministry of Health.


Most of the client group attending Tai Chi were not able to attend Tai Chi in their community as a result of their brain injuries. Luana very quickly and unobtrusively adapted her teaching style to accommodate peoples' needs so that those who had physical impairments were very easily able to keep up with the requirements. For those people who took longer to understand instructions or needed them repeated often, she willingly did this.
